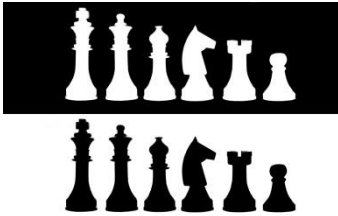




Annual House Chess Tournament
