Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to my earlier messages and letters, I am writing to let you know of the arrangements for school over the next two days. As many of you will know, the Government has made an announcement that schools will close to the majority of students from Friday afternoon until further notice.

It is our intention to keep the school open until Friday. However, due to increasing staff absence, we have to close the school to more students. School will be closed to students in Years 9 and 10.

We hope to remain open until Friday, dependent on staffing, for the following year groups:

- Year 13
- Year 12
- Year 11
- Year 8
- Year 7

In addition, if your son is in Year 9 or Year 10 and you have significant issues with childcare, or would like him to have a school dinner, he is more than welcome in school. All students (apart from those in Year 12 and Year 13) attending school should come in normal school uniform.

**Students on Free School Meals** are welcome to come to school for lunch. They should sign into school by 1.25 for lunch. We will have **supervised study facilities** in school for Year 9 and 10 students who come to school.
