




## **International Poetry Day**

# WES Physicists at UK's largest particle accelerator facility



Year 13 WES Physicists went on a trip to the Harwell Science Campus in Oxfordshire to visit the offices and laboratories of Public Health England as well as the UK's largest particle accelerator facility at the Diamond Light Source which is part of the Rutherford Appleton Laboratories.

Highlights included being able to visit a beam line experiment which was investigating the nature of magnetic fields and standing inside a low radiation lab which was manufactured from steel salvaged from a 1915 naval war cruiser as this lowered the background count rate!
