Students will return to school on 5<sup>th</sup> January, on a staggered timetable to complete Lateral Flow Testing. We have been instructed to do this by the government so that we can minimise the number of students returning to school with a coronavirus infection.

We will not be collecting consent as we have done this previously for testing earlier in the year.
