Dear families

I hope that you have all had a positive return to September routines and that our students have returned home having had positive experiences at school. I am writing home in this letter with some updates and items before our first newsletter edition, and with an accompanying communication guide that we hope will support further strengthened relationships across our school community.

Attendance at school

Like other schools nationally, we recognise the importance of excellent attendance to support students' academic achievement and well-being. It is particularly important that students get into good routines of attendance and punctuality at the start of the year, and I wrote in our <u>letter on 5th September</u> about how we expect families to support this at home. Recent data analysis shows that one in five students nationwide are "persistently absent" and that 58% of Year 7-11 students who missed school at the start of the year went on to miss at least 10% of sessions across the whole academic year. This was true for 13% of Year 1-6 and 21% of Year 7-11 students who were ever-present at the start of the year. So students who missed school at the start of the year were 2.7 times more likely to be persistently absent than those who didn't.

We want to work to support students to attend school, and also work with families to fully address any reasons why students are reluctant to attend. For us to do this, we must insist that you follow <u>our absence procedures</u>. Although it is tempting, I know, for families to plan holidays or other visits outside of school holidays because the prices are so different, these absences will not be authorised. Any other requests for planned absence must be made using the forms available online.
