I wrote to you at the start of the week about the need for a limited service in the canteen in the first few days back. With the support of Camden colleagues I'm pleased to say that the canteen has been able to offer hot food for students in the last two days, and Ms Gkelezi and her team have worked hard to guide the students through this process.
