Dear families,

Thank you to all parents and carers who attended Year 7 parents' evening last night, with the opportunity to meet teachers face to face and discuss the progress that students have made in their first term of secondary school. We know that in Year 7, coming into the school and getting a face-to-face sense of students' experience and meeting teachers personally is very important and that was fed back to us.

However, we have also heard from parents who welcomed online evenings during the last few years, and so will continue with these in Years 8-10. We have made this decision in particular:

- To ensure that 5-minute slots run to time, ensuring that all parents with an appointment have an equal discussion with teachers
- To support parents who are juggling parents evening with evening work commitments, and can attend online when face to face would not be possible
- To support families who aren't able to organise care for younger children that would enable them to attend parents' evening

Supporting Camden Food Bank this Christmas

As mentioned in last week's letter, from 5th-15th December our school community will be collecting donated items for The <u>Camden Food Bank</u>, which has been overwhelmed in recent weeks with local people needing help.

Nationally almost 1.3 million emergency food parcels were given out in the 6 months up to September 2022, with almost 500,000 of these being handed out to children, according to the leading charity The Trussell Trust. As the cost-of-living crisis deepens the Food Bank is appealing for donations to help local families in need.

The items required are:

- Tinned fish & meat tuna, sardines, mackerel, hot dogs, meatballs, meat in sauce, Fray Bentos etc.
- Tinned fruit and vegetables
- Pasta Sauce
- Long life milk Whole, Semi, Soya, Oat or Almond
- Breakfast cereal Cornflakes, Coco Pops, Rice Krispies, Fruit and Fibre, etc.
- Jam, peanut butter, chocolate spread
- Long life juice and squash
- Cooking oil
- Coffee, tea and hot chocolate
- Christmas sweets and biscuits
- Toiletries shampoo, shower gel, toilet rolls
- Washing powder for Laundry, Washing up Liquid
- Christmas presents suitable for children and teenagers

Items can be dropped off at the collection point in the Library between 8am-4pm on weekdays, and there will be a final opportunity to contribute at our Winter Entertainment Evening on 15th December.
