Mock Exam Procedures

- Come at least **20 minutes before the exam** – Be in school at 8.30
- Morning Exams **START at 9am**
- Afternoon exams **START at 1.30pm**
- **Full uniform**

- **In MORNINGS** – go to your Form room – your tutors will direct you to the exam.
- You will be sent from form rooms to
- Go to **BAG DROP Room 30** in silence when told, to put **bags, earphones, watches and mobile phones** in. Once bags are dropped off go to the exam room
- You **MUST KNOW** your seat in advance
- **Take your equipment with you**
- Please do follow instructions when in corridors and waiting to enter the Hall
- **Talks stops at the door as soon as you get in the Hall**
- **Calm / silent entrance to exam room essential**

In the Hall

- **Once in the hall, no talk.**
- Go to your place look for your card number/name on the table. There will be a seating plan on the doors so you can see where you are going to be seated
- **Sit down and wait in silence for instructions.**
- Listen Carefully to instructions.
- **If you are seen communicating in any way or form, regardless the reason, Invigilators will not warn you but will report to the school.**
- **If talking during and after exam when in the hall although you will be asked to be silent pupils will still be disqualified and will get 0. I will call parents, and letter will be sent home directly.**
- **If you need help put your hand up an invigilator will come.**

If late for your exam

- If you arrive late to the exam you will not be allowed into the exam hall.
- You will sit the exam late that day.

If you are sick.

- Dentist and doctor's appointment will not be accepted.
 - (reschedule if you know you have an appointment)
- If you are genuinely sick, make sure your parent phones the school and talks to Mr Pratt or Mr Lane. We'll make sure you sit your exam at a later date. Any students absent for sickness must provide a medical certificate with the date of the exam.
 - (if you do not have a medical certificate it will result in 0 and still have to sit the exam)
- This are the rules given by the GCSE exam board. We have no choice in the matter and we need to make sure you understand the consequence of the points discussed above.
