Admissions Policy Consultation for September 2027

I am writing to inform you about a proposed change to our school's admission policy and to invite your valued input as a stakeholder in our community.

In accordance with the Department for Education's School Admissions Code, we are undertaking a consultation process to consider a modification to our current admission policy. This proposed change maintains an adherence to the principles outlined in the code and address certain considerations unique to our school community. The proposals have been agreed by the school's Governing Body and discussed with the schools directly referenced in the policy.

The primary alterations under consideration are:

- the introduction of a provision to offer places to siblings of female students already on roll at Camden School for Girls, as well as La Sainte Union and Parliament Hill. This proposed change reflects our commitment to fostering a sense of community while ensuring the best possible educational environment for all our students in a single sex environment.
- The introduction of a provision to offer places to the children of staff in other local schools.
- The adaptation of our aptitude provision to include Modern Foreign Languages as well as Music.

We believe that by extending admission priority to siblings of female students in neighbouring girls' schools and the children of local school staff, we can contribute to the cohesion and continuity of learning experiences for families within our community. The inclusion of Modern Foreign Languages within our aptitude provision reflects our distinctive curriculum offer, and a longstanding strength of the school. These measures are in line with our dedication to inclusivity, diversity, and creating an environment that is conducive to the holistic development of each child.

Your input is vital to this process, and we invite you to share your thoughts, concerns, or suggestions regarding this proposed change. We value the diverse perspectives of our stakeholders, and your feedback will be considered carefully before any decision is made.
